Television

1. No television on school nights. Weekends and holidays only.
2. TV is limited to ____ minutes/hours per day.
3. All shows must be approved by parents and can be turned off at any time if inappropriate.
4. Mom and Dad have the final decision on all TV, movies, etc.
5. There will occasionally be TV “fasts” where the whole family will not watch TV.

Phones

1. All phone conversations, texts, and other information can be heard or read by Mom and Dad. Do not delete texts.
2. Phones are not to be used in your bedroom except for one phone call when given permission by Mom and Dad. Phone comes back out of room after call.
3. Parents may put a tracking or recording program on your phone at any time. We will tell you if we do.
4. We as parents have a right to monitor your phone, even if you purchase it yourself, because you are underage.
5. All phones are to be in the recharging station in the parent’s room at night.
6. Parents have a right to take the phone at any point. A phone is a privilege, not a right.

Ipods, Ipads, Tablets

1. Tablets must be used in a visible room in the house, never in the bedroom. Must be used in the line of sight of Mom and Dad.
2. Tablets are not connected to the internet unless permission is given, and then only for one specific task (such as to download a game).
3. May be used for ____ minutes on school nights, after homework is complete. On non-school nights, for ____ minutes. A timer must be used.
4. Dad and Mom have the final say on all games and apps.

Computers and Laptops

1. School work always take priority. Games, social media, e-mail, etc. only after school work is finished.
2. No limit on time for school work.
3. For other activities, _____ minutes on school nights. _____ minutes on non-school nights.

4. Internet use is allowed when proper monitoring system is installed and working properly. If any inappropriate internet use happens, internet access will be denied or supervised by a parent.
5. Laptops are never to be used in bedrooms. Computers are only to be used in visible sight of parents.

General Safety

1. Keep personal information private online, including on social media such as Facebook.
2. Only chat or friend people that you know in real life.
3. Mom or Dad have the right to monitor all social media and “friend” you on all social media sights.
4. Parents can require approval for all online purchases, internet uses, and social media purchases.
5. Be smart! Always be aware of what is going on around you online and with whom you are interacting.
